

Accessibility information

At Yorkshire Lavender we want everyone to be able to have an enjoyable experience with us. So that you can understand the accessibility of our location prior to your visit, we have included everything you need to know below.

Yorkshire Lavender is situated on farmland, overlooking the Howardian Hills. As such, there are areas of uneven and sloping ground to be aware of.

Car park

The spacious car park slopes gently towards the main building. We have disabled parking at the front of the main building.

Main building

The main building can be accessed on foot and via wheelchair and mobility scooter.

Shop

The shop, situated in the main building, has access for wheelchair users and mobility scooters.

Toilets

We have an accessible toilet situated in the main building.

EJ's Tea Room

Our team room, also found in the main building, is wheelchair and mobility scooter accessible with plenty of seating options, both inside and outdoors on the patio, overlooking the gardens.

Plant nursery

The plant nursery, located behind the main building, is accessible for wheelchairs and mobility scooters.

The gardens

We make every effort to keep the grass in our gardens at a low level but periods of wet weather can impact accessibility for mobility scooters and wheelchairs.

The gardens have sloping areas which may be more difficult to access, depending on your level of mobility.
